COVID UPDATE - #15/2021

The Premier has announced that the lockdown will continue for the Brisbane and Moreton Bay local government areas until 6pm Saturday 3 July 2021.

During the lockdown the only reasons people should be outside of their homes are for:

1. Essential education and work that cannot be done at home or to obtain health care services, including getting your vaccination.
2. Care or support of a vulnerable family member.
3. Essential shopping in your local community.
4. Exercising outdoors with no more than one person (not from your household) in your local community.

During the lockdown the following venues and services at our retirement villages will be closed:

- Cafes.
- Devotions.
- Halls.
- Libraries.
- Pools.
- Hairdressers and beauty services.

Please continue to monitor the situation via the media, as I will not be providing a further update over the weekend.

In relation to visitor restrictions to aged care, based on previous lockdowns, I anticipate that the restrictions will continue beyond the general community lockdown. I will let you know when we have firm information about when these restrictions will be lifted.
