COVID UPDATE - #16/2021

As you will have heard, from 6pm Saturday 3 July, the lockdown in Brisbane and Moreton Bay local government areas was lifted. However, a number of restrictions remain in place. In this update I will summarise the restrictions that impact on our villages / homes, however, you should review the full list and details of restrictions on the Queensland Health website.

General Restrictions

- You must carry a face mask with you at all times when you are not at home.
- You must wear a face mask when you are not at home (especially when you are indoors and where you cannot socially distance).
- You can have up to 30 people gather in your home.
- Businesses have restrictions on the number of people who are allowed on premises.
- You must be seated when eating and drinking in restaurants and cafes.

Retirement villages

The following venues and services at our retirement villages will recommence / re-open this week, subject to the prevailing restrictions. Please observe the number limit signs that are posted at each venue and follow any reasonable directions from staff.

- Cafes.
- Devotions.
- Halls.
- Libraries.
- Pools.
- Hairdressers and beauty services.

Aged care

The Queensland Government has advised that lockdown restrictions on visitors to residential aged care facilities continue. This will probably be for the next two weeks. We will let you know when these restrictions are lifted.
